



GET READY TO VOTE



Yes, there are state and local elections in Virginia this fall.

Are you able to vote?

Yes, I am registered to vote.

No, I am not registered to vote.



I want to vote absentee.

- You can go online to apply to vote absentee by mail with this QR code *OR*
- You can complete a Virginia Absentee Ballot Application. Return the completed and signed form to your local registrar's office by mail, fax, or scanned attachment to an email.



I want to vote early.

You can vote in-person and early for any reason. Go to one of the in-person early voting locations in Fairfax County **September 22-November 4.**



I plan to vote on Election Day, November 7.

- Use this QR code to go online and find your voting location.
- Bring your ID.
- Polls are open 6am-7pm.

To be eligible to register to vote in Virginia, a person must:

- Be a resident of Virginia (a person who has come to Virginia for temporary purposes and intends to return to another state is **not** considered a resident for voting purposes).
- Be a U. S. Citizen.
- Be 18 years old (any person who is 17 years old and will be eighteen years of age at the next general election shall be permitted to register in advance and also vote in any intervening primary or special election).
- Not be registered and plan to vote in another state.
- Not currently declared mentally incompetent by a court of law.
- If convicted of a felony, your right to vote must have been restored.

To register, you can complete and return a Virginia Voter Registration Application at this voter registration drive. *OR* use the QR code given above for absentee voting to search online.
